
Installing a WashPod unit has many benefits:


The WashPod Models

Large External


- fits on patio, drive or in the garden with a connecting lobby, if needed
- sufficient room for 2 carers, trollies and wheelchairs
- hoist can be fitted
- highly insulated, waterproof outer case
- internal hot water tank and a pressurised shower unit
- electric, underfloor heating together and heated towel rail to maintain minimum temperature at 25°C if required
- installation in 4—5 days
- fully compliant





Large Internal

- fits into a large room or spacious double garage
- sufficient room for 2 carers, trollies and wheelchairs
- · hoist can be fitted
- installation in 2 3 days
- fully compliant






Standard External






Compact (External and Internal)

- great for when space is at a premium
- can be installed in a conservatory
- versatile addition of a platform to gain wheelchair turning circle
- Ramp on one side can be removed for tight installations
- Panels can be configured to accommodate different orientations
- Installation in as little as 1 day

- highly insulated, waterproof outer case
- electric underfloor heating together and heated towel rail to maintain minimum temperature at 25°C if required






Micro Internal (& Mini with a Toilet)

- designed for the most limited spaces such as an existing bedroom or utility room
- minimum space required (1.5m L x 1.2m W x 2.0m H plus ramp). The Mini with a toilet is slightly larger at 1.75m L)
- its bi-fold doors allow carer access from outside if needed
- fits snugly into the corner of rooms or even in utility rooms if the configuration suits
- only takes half a day to install
